THE ORIGINAL PECTORAL BALM -ORIGINAL INGREDIENTS FORMULA



HERBICOL - THE ORIGINAL HERBAL PECTORAL BALM

Contains beeswax and 10 herbal extracts: Eyebright, marigold, eucalyptus, thyme general, Ribwort, elderberry, yarrow, violet scented, Moorish mallow, horsetail. For supplemental application in therapy care during upper respiratory tract infections, colds, fever, cough and phlegm.

Indication:

- respiratory problems (asthma, bronchitis, etc.)
- persistent cough.
- runny and stuffy nose.
- calming of skin irritated around the nose.

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ACTIVE INGREDIENTS:

100 g occlusive emulsion (W/O), 1.0 g of ointment contains camphor and 2.0 g of a mixture of natural substances (oils, flavonoids and carotenoids) as standardized liquid propylene glycol extracts (skylight, marigold, eucalyptus, thyme, plantain, elderberry, yarrow, violet, mallow and horsetail).

OTHER SUPPORTIVE INGREDIENTS:

It contains special micellar system composed of the original mixture of waxes, mineral and hydrogenated vegetable oils, herbal extracts, and a minor proportion of emulsifiers. Micellar system is responsible for the specificity of the crumbly texture of the emulsion and enables gentle, limited natural active substances pass through the natural barrier of the skin. Micellar system significantly reduces irritating and allergenic potential of natural substances contained in the skin.

INDICATION

Using of the pectoral balm is indicated as an additional local application during therapy care of upper respiratory tract infections - cold, rhinitis, cough and phlegm. Also the using of the pectoral balm is recommended for local application into the skin around the nose during cold, running and stuffy nose. Regarding rhinitis it is recommended to use it as inhalation way.

APPLICATION

According to problems you have apply several times a day into the skin of chest and back. Rub the balm gently into the skin to be completely absorbed or apply it as a breast wrap. However the balm could be applied also in the round nose area or in the temples area. Slight lumpiness is not a fault, but a natural characteristic of the product.

WARNING:

ONLY for external use! The product is indicated for children 3+. Do not apply to or around eye area or mucous membranes and also into the injured skin. Do not use the balm in case of an allergy to any of ingredient contained in.

EFFICIENT AND MECHANISM OF ACTION

Camphor with other essential oils in a occlusive emulsion with micelle has hyperaemic effect, calms, supports blood circulation, relieves skin and respiratory muscles. Camphor doesn't affect physiological homeostasis of skin barrier. According to pharmacokinetic studies, the amount of camphor when applied topically absorbed into the body system is not significant, but the trace amount. Trace amounts of camphor and essential oils are also secreted into the mucus in the respiratory tract, which can inhibit the growth of pathogenic bacteria. Local effects of camphor are supported with a moisturizing, an antibacterial and a derivative activity of propylene glycol extracts of 10 herbs. For local application into the skin there are important mainly: Eyebright (*Euphrasia rostkoviana*), yarrow (*Achillea millefolium*) due to their regenerating and antioxidant effects, then also carotenoids and flavonoids of marigold (*Calendula officinalis*) due to their antioxidant and anti-inflammatory effects. For local use as inhalation therapy care there are important the significant antiseptic activity of eucalyptus and thyme oils (against *Klebsiella pneumoniae*, *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*, *Staphylococcus aureus*, *Haemophilus influenzae*, etc.). Those mechanisms support additionally the relief from symptoms of cold and infection diseases of the upper respiratory tract (rhinitis, phlegm-mucus, cough).

CONTRAINDICATION:

Hypersensitivity to camphor and essential oils.

SIDE EFFECTS:

Burning and redness or allergic skin reaction.

INTOLERANCE WITH DRUGS:
